

Who will be the **NEXT COMMANDER IN CHIEF?**

DONALD TRUMP

ON TORTURE:

"If [torture] doesn't work, they deserve it anyway."¹

ON SOLITARY CONFINEMENT:

Trump Administration federal Bureau of Prisons instituted total lockdown of over 165,000 people in June 2020 during national protests for racial justice.²

ON GUANTANAMO:

"It costs a fortune to operate it, and I think it's crazy," but also, Trump said he will "load [Guantanamo] up with some bad dudes."³

ON WELCOMING REFUGEES:

Trump cut refugee admissions to a record low while saying that refugees are "overwhelming public resources, overcrowding schools and inundating your hospitals... it's a disgrace what they've done."⁴

ON RELIGIOUS LIBERTY:

From a press release: "Donald J. Trump is calling for a total and complete shutdown of Muslims entering the United States." As President, he has tried 3 times to ban people from predominantly Islamic countries from entering the U.S.⁵

JOE BIDEN

ON TORTURE:

"This was a mistake, we should not have done what we've done, and we will not do it again."⁶

ON SOLITARY CONFINEMENT:

Biden's criminal justice policy plan promises to "end the practice of solitary confinement, with very limited exceptions such as protecting the life of an imprisoned person."⁷

ON GUANTANAMO:

Biden "continues to support closing the detention center" which "undermines American national security by fueling terrorist recruitment and is at odds with our values as a country."⁸

ON WELCOMING REFUGEES:

"As President, I will raise the annual global refugee admissions cap to 125,000, and seek to raise it over time commensurate with our responsibility, our values, and the unprecedented global need."⁹

ON RELIGIOUS LIBERTY:

"I will end the Muslim ban on day one. Day one. And I will work with Congress to pass hate crimes legislation like the Jabara-Heyer No Hate Act and the End Racial and Religious Profiling Act."¹⁰
